1. Qualified Immunity Update – This topic will focus on states that have adopted new laws to limit and/or eliminate qualified immunity. We will discuss the ultimate effect of those new laws.
 2. Post-*Janus* Update – The demise of public-sector unions that many predicted post-*Janus* simply has not occurred. The courts are consistent in declining to extend/expand *Janus*. Accordingly, any major changes moving forward are more likely to come from state legislatures. This topic will address post-*Janus* legislation and litigation. We will introduce the Ballotpedia page wherein all bills from 2018-present and litigation are tracked and summarized.
 3. Civilian Review Boards Update – This topic will build on last year wherein we introduced civilian review boards and our recommended model—the audit model. We will provide an update on where many cities stand and how they are implementing these review bodies.
